






## Neighborhood Cleanups

#### Where to Place Pile

Place items at the curb, but not in the gutter. Piles should not block sidewalks and should be at least 5 or more feet from other objects. Please separate large items from the pile.

#### When to Set Out Pile: Early set out penalty \$166.30.

Place material out by 6 a.m. on your scheduled service day, but no more than 48 hours in advance. There may be a 1 or 2-day collection delay due to load factors. Piles that are set out earlier than 48 hours in advance will be subject to an Improper Large Item Collection penalty of \$166.30.


#### Pile Over 10 Yards: Minimum Fee of \$112.91


Pile size is limited to 10 cubic yards or about 10'x7'x4'. Piles that exceed the allotted size may be subject to an "excessive pile" charge. Excessive pile charges may increase based upon material quantity set out for collection.

#### **Acceptable Materials:**

- ✓ Appliances (tape all doors shut)
- ✓ Barbecues
- ✓ Branches (maximum 4" in diameter & 6' in length)
- ✓ Carpet/rugs
- Electronic waste: TVs, computers, monitors, faxes, printers, cell phones, etc.
- ✓ Furniture (chairs, sofas, dining tables)
- Leaves (must be bagged)
- ✓ Mattresses
- Microwave ovens
- ✓ Plastic pipes (6' length maximum)
- ✓ Tires (limit 4)
- ✓ Toys
- Untreated Wood (lumber and disassembled fencing; MUST be bundled and under 6' in length)



# Free Pickup Service for Used Motor Oil and Oil Filters



## Disposal of used motor oil:

- Place motor oil in containers provided by Republic Services or use a clear, plastic milk or water jug
- Tape lid to close it securely if you are using your own container
- Place jugs at the curb next to your recycling cart (maximum of three gallons of oil per pickup)



## Disposal of used motor oil filters:

- Drain oil containers for 24 hours before bagging; only one filter per bag
- Place oil filters in a sealable plastic bag (or oil filter bag provided by Republic Services)
- Wipe excess oil off bag and seal
- Hang the filter bag on the used oil container and place at the curb next to your recycling cart

Republic Services will leave replacement containers and filter bags. To obtain an oil recycling container or filter bag, please call **916.638.9000**.



# Free Pickup Services for Household Batteries

Place batteries in a clear and sealed plastic bag, and place the bag ON TOP of the blue recycling cart on your collection day.

#### Household batteries include:

- Dry cell
- 9V\*
- Alkaline Lithium\*
- Rechargeable
- \* Any batteries labeled lithium batteries or 9V MUST be taped at both ends to prevent a fire/explosion.

# Best Practices for Food Waste Recycling Mitigate Odors and Pests, etc.

#### **Freeze Your Food Scraps**

Keep food scraps frozen to minimize odors and decomposition before your scheduled collection day.

## **Top Cart Contents** with Yard Waste

Pad the bottom and top of your food waste with yard waste like leaves, grass clippings, or "clean" wood shavings to absorb liquids. Wood shavings can also be used to help reduce odors.

#### **Use BPI-Certified or Paper Bags**

Place food waste in paper bags or BPIcertified compostable bags inside your organic waste cart.

#### **Double-Bag Food Waste**

Double-bag your food waste to keep the contents sealed and reduce the risk of leaks.

#### **Tie Bags Securely**

Tie BPI-certified compostable bags at the top to keep food waste inside, leaving room for a secure knot.

#### **Line Your Cart with Newspaper**

Line your countertop pail or organics cart with newspaper and replace it regularly to help maintain cleanliness.

#### Place Cart at the Curb Weekly

Place your cart at the curb every week, regardless of the amount of material inside.


#### **Top with Cold Ashes**

Ashes from fireplace or BBQ may be disposed of in the green cart and used to absorb food waste. Note: Ashes must be completely cooled down.

#### **Layer with Paper Towels**

Add a layer of food-soiled paper towels or napkins to your green cart to absorb liquids from food waste.

- · Aseptic packaging (milk, soy & juice cartons)
- Ceramics
- · Children's toys (batteries removed)
- Cotton and clothing
- Flimsy plastic, plastic bags or bubble wrap
- · Hoses, cords, cables and wiring
- Light bulbs (halogen, incandescent and LED)
- Packing peanuts (stuffed into a plastic bag)
- · Waxed paper





### What Does Not Go Inside My **Black/Brown Trash Cart?**

- Electronics (TVs and computers)
- Food waste
- CFL bulbs (twisty bulbs and tubes), neon lights, and hazardous materials
- · Hot ashes and coals
- Household batteries of ANY kind\*
- Medical waste and sharps (syringes, etc.\*\*)







**Reminder:** Place carts out by 6 a.m. on your collection day and bring carts in as soon as possible after your collection.

# Free Appointment-Based Sharps Collection


- Republic Services provides FREE front door collection of homegenerated hypodermic needles, syringes and lancets (by appointment).

## Free Extra Leaf Collection - Must Be Bagged!

Republic Services provides free extra leaf collection in November, December and January. Place leaves in up to six, 30-gallon plastic bags and place them next to your organic waste cart to be picked up on collection day each week. Do not put food waste in the extra leaf collection bags.

## 6 Free Additional Bags Each Week

30-Gallon Bags, 35 lbs. max per bag

### **Preventing Container Contamination**

#### 1. Use the right cart.

Ensure you have the right size and number of carts based on usage. To make changes, call Republic Services at 916.638.9000.


#### 2. Use the right bag.

No plastic bags (unless BPI-certified) should be placed in the organic waste cart. Residents can use paper bags or place the organic waste loosely in the cart.

#### 3. Include the right material.

## **Holiday Treecycling**

#### There are two ways to recycle live-cut trees:

- 1. Cut your tree into pieces to fit inside your **green organic waste** cart, with the lid closed. They will be picked up on your regular organic waste collection day.
- Place your tree curbside (next to your organic waste cart.)
   For a quick and easy pick up please make sure the holiday tree does not exceed 6 feet in length, if it is longer than 6 feet it can be cut in half. Holiday tree pickup will be weekly from December 26 January 16.






